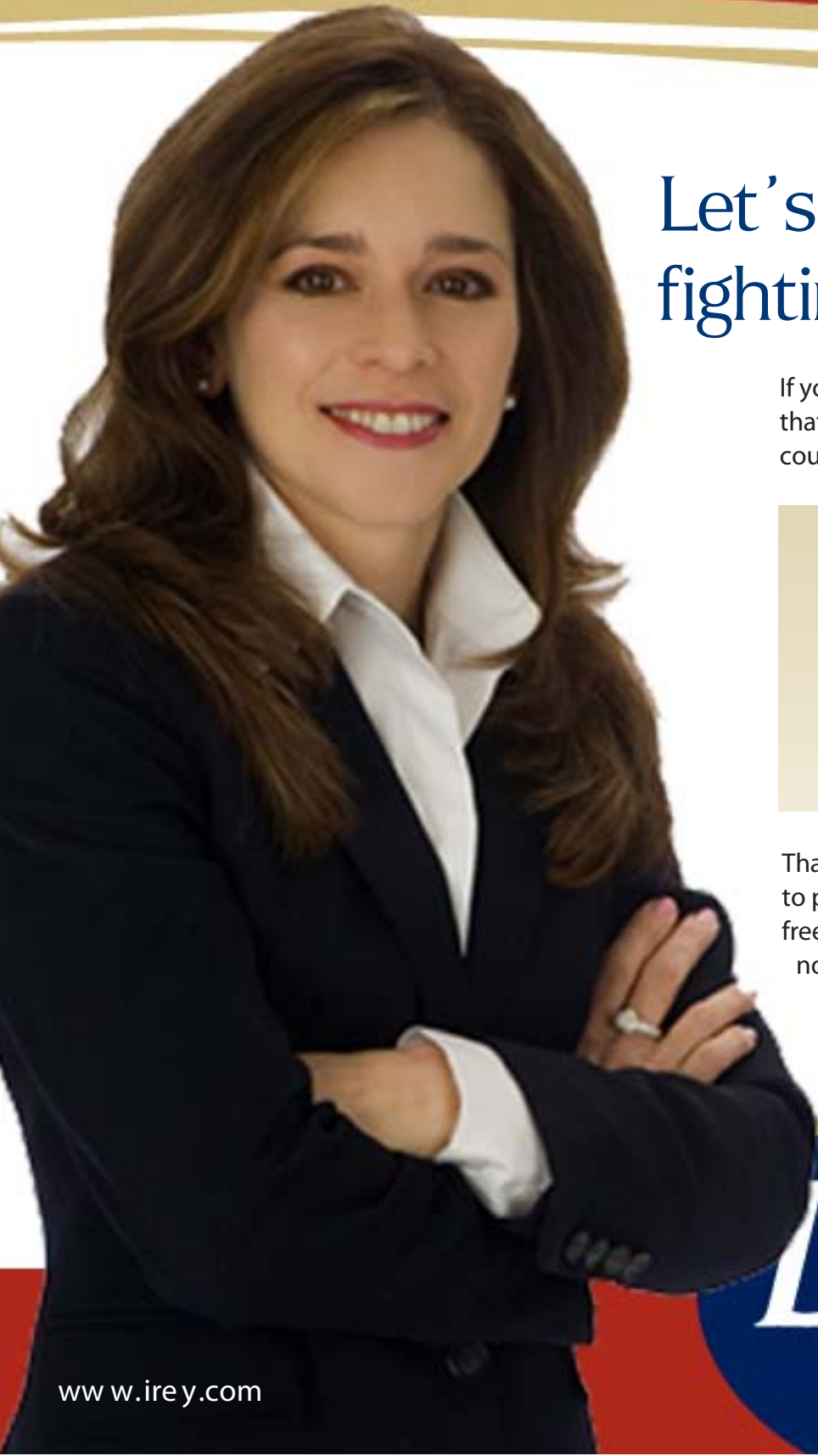


Diana Irey Vaughan.
